1 knot = 1.852 kph = 1.15 mph

mach = 1225.04 kph at seal level

1.7 mach is the speed of sound = 1304.36 mph

Clues can be on either side of the road unless it is specified - I have 4 paws, so lefts and rights are tough for me...

If it isn't a question or an instruction, then it is just information to help you stay on course.

Proceed to the stop sign, turn left.

Proceed straight through the first light.

Go straight through the stop sign at 10th Street

In the round about, exit onto 27th street (be careful, there is a lot of construction in this area)

Go straight through the round about at Grand Ave.

Right onto Glen Ave (also SH 82)

Continue straight at Blake Avenue stop light

NOTE: Beautiful Mount Sopris in front of us!!! I didn't see too many mountains in Oklahoma.....

Go straight at stop sign onto Upper River Rd

Mile 6

NOTE: There are some speed bumps coming soon

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Turn Right onto Smith Hill Way
 Carefully turn right onto 82
 Proceed on 82 past Mile Markers 30, 29, 27, 25 and 24 (and maybe others)
 Right at Two Rivers Road Stop Light (yes, you were here before)
 Right onto Midland Avenue, becomes Frying Pan Road as you leave downtown area.

Now is my FAVORITE part!!! I am learning my numbers, and this activity will help me so much!!!

For the next 14 miles, record the first road sign you see after each mile marker. If there are none, state "none". The first Mile Marker is on the right, is the number "1" and is on a small CDOT road sign. The road sign you record must be a CDOT "official" road sign, not something like "no trespassing" or a realtors sign. The sign must contain words, numbers or a combination of both and it must be on the right side of your car as you travel.

The trap! The next CDOT placed road sign was the next mile marker

Turn Right into the Reudi Reservoir Boat Ramp and take an immediate right again to go down the driveway.

There are public restrooms at the bottom of the driveway near the boat launch. The ramp employees request that you don't congregate and block access for the boaters, but we are welcome to use the bathrooms.

Go back to the top of the hill, turn left and turn left onto Frying Pan Road, heading back to town.

Going down the Mountain: For the next 14 miles, record the first road sign you see on the right after each mile marker following the same rules you had coming up the mountain. The markers you saw previously are 2 sided so you will now see them on the left.

Stay on Frying Pan Lane, which becomes Midland Avenue.

Proceed straight at the stop sign through town

Proceed straight through 2nd stop sign, and go over the river.

At the T, go right and carefully merge onto 82 using the on ramp in front of you.

Continue on 82 back to Glenwood Springs and turn left at the stop light at 27th

Straight through the round about

Take first exit out of second round about onto Midland Avenue N

Stay on Midland Avenue until you see the Marriott on your left

Park your car and turn in your completed tour packages in the lobby of the Marriott Courtyard before 4:30 PM. I will be there waiting to greet you!!!

Your tour package will be exchanged for the tie breakers . You will have 10 minutes to complete the tie breakers and return them to me.
